01 12+ Months Out — The Big Decisions

- ☐ Set a rough budget: it shapes almost every decision after this
- ☐ Choose your date, or at least a season if the exact day isn't locked yet
- ☐ Book your ceremony and reception venue
- ☐ Book your photographer: the best ones book out furthest in advance
- ☐ Start a guest list, even a rough one

02 9 to 6 Months Out — Locking In Your Team

- ☐ Book your florist, DJ or band, and caterer
- ☐ Order or design your invitations
- ☐ Choose your attire: allow real time for alterations
- ☐ Book hair and makeup
- ☐ Start building your day-of timeline

03 3 Months Out — Finalizing

- ☐ Finalize your guest count and send it to your caterer
- ☐ Confirm final details with every vendor
- ☐ Finalize your seating chart, if you're using one
- ☐ Schedule your rehearsal

04 The Month Of — Final Checks

- ☐ Confirm arrival times with every vendor
- ☐ Pack an emergency kit, or make sure someone has one
- ☐ Delegate day-of tasks: you should not be the one managing logistics
- ☐ Give yourself permission to just be present
